



Animal Dermatology Clinic- Austin Scheduling a New Patient Appointment

To schedule your new patient appointment:

1. Please call your primary care veterinary clinic and ask them to share your pet's Full Medical Records with ADC-Austin. Your veterinarian can provide the records to us in several ways:
 - Via the [Refer Patient](#) found on our website
 - By email to infoaustin@adcmg.com
 - By fax to 512-477-4826

It is important you request the medical record from every clinic which has treated your pet as Dr. Nichols needs a full lifetime history.

2. Please complete and submit **both** the [New Patient](#) and [New Client](#) forms on our website.

After we receive your pet's medical records and both the New Patient Form and New Client Form, the patient care team at ADC-Austin will contact you to schedule an appointment. We cannot book an appointment for your pet without receipt of these items.

To secure your pet's appointment, your credit card information is required. This information will be collected by phone and will be stored in our safeguarded system. Your credit card may be used for future medication refill requests, missed appointment fees, etc.

We are currently experiencing high patient and appointment scheduling volume and thank you for your understanding. We also maintain an active waiting list and will contact you to move up in the schedule if the opportunity arises. We advise you to continue the treatment plan from your regular veterinarian in the meantime.
